Local Weekly Nets

You do not need a tone to listen into a weekly NET. You can hear N/C and stations but you won't be able to respond.

If you are not a regular NET member, wait until the NCS calls for visitors. If you want to participate then, the below NETs require a tone to be heard by N/C (Net Control).

How to Check in with a local, directed NET

A net control station (NCS) initiates the net operations, maintains order, directs the net activities, and then terminates net operations in an orderly way.

When the NET opens, be sure you can hear the NCS clearly and understand the instructions. Participants are called in order.

When called for your check in, give your call sign once (phonetically if you're using voice). If the NCS doesn't copy your call sign the first time, repeat your call sign, or the NCS can ask one of the listening stations to relay your call sign.
